The Horseshoe Casino Baltimore will be one of the first LEED Gold Casinos in the country. It is the first LEED Building for Caesars and will be a model to other casinos in its efficiency. The building collects and stores storm water for use in all lavatories and for all landscaping irrigation. A Combined Heat and Power system is helping the casino to achieve serious savings in their operational expenses as well. With



the contractor, we were able to ensure a large quantity of materials incorporated into the project were from within 500 miles of the project and contained recycled content.
